Terms and Conditions

1. The Brilliant Minded Women Foundation reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, amend or cancel the Scholarship Funds at any time without notice if the Scholar does not follow the Terms and Condition of the Scholarship Program.
2. The following persons are NOT eligible to receive a scholarship; Program applicants (“Applicants”) who provide false information to Brilliant Minded Women Foundation any time.
3. To be eligible for a Scholarship, Applicants must:
 - a) have permanent resident status
 - b) certify that all the information provided on the Program application form (“Application”) and in all the accompanying documents is true, accurate and complete to the best of their knowledge; and;
 - c) Be available for an interview in the city located within their region on the day chosen by Brilliant Minded Women Foundation.
4. A Scholarship awarded under the Program can be held at any college or university in Canada approved by Brilliant Minded Women Foundation (“Approved School”). The Scholarship recipient is responsible for securing admission to an Approved School of their choice, in accordance with the requirements and deadlines of each school.
5. The Brilliant Minded Women Foundation Scholarship will have a value of no more than forty thousand Canadian Dollars over four years paid directly to the recipient.
6. The Recipient will receive mentorship, at the sole discretion of Brilliant Minded Women Organization.
7. A Recipient must:
 - a) Attend an Approved School on a full-time/part -time basis (as defined by the school),
 - b) Pass all courses.
8. Recipients may change disciplines, programs and/or Approved Schools during the Scholarship term. Grades or marks obtained in supplementary or repeated examinations in the same academic year (including summer sessions) will be considered under extenuating circumstances.
9. If a Recipient fails a course, which is not remediated in the same school year, except due to serious illness, accident or death in the immediate family (supporting medical documentation may be required), he/she will forfeit the Scholarship. Recipients who fail to drop a course or courses before the deadline outlined by their school will be responsible for any remaining tuition and penalty fees due after such deadline.
10. Recipients may defer enrollment in an Approved School for up to one year, or they may interrupt their studies for up to one year, on one occasion only, at the successful conclusion of an academic year. Reinstatement of the Scholarship will be conditional on reacceptance at an Approved School. Recipients who fail to return to school after one year deferment or who drop out of school will forfeit the Scholarship.
11. A Scholarship may be terminated at any time by Brilliant Minded Women Foundation, upon the occurrence of any behaviour on the part of the Recipient that Brilliant Minded Women Foundation, in its sole discretion, deems inappropriate, including but not limited to any misconduct in the workplace (during summer employment) that may result in termination “for cause.”
12. All Recipients must inform themselves as to the tax consequences of receiving the Scholarship.
13. All Recipients will be required to sign a Declaration and Release which will entitle Brilliant Minded Women Organization/Foundation to use the Recipient’s name, city and province of residence, and photograph, without further compensation for any publicity carried out by Brilliant Minded Women Organization/Foundation with respect to the Program.
14. Brilliant Minded Women Foundation has an established network of organizations that provide funds for the Scholarships. All Recipients must become active paying members of the Brilliant Minded Women Organization.
15. Once you earn your degree/diploma/certificate from the Approved School, you will automatically join the Scholars Alumni Network. Membership in the Scholars Alumni Network includes but is not limited to: invitations to Brilliant Minded Women Organization/Foundation events; participation on Brilliant Minded Women Foundation Scholarship advisory councils; and invitations to join Brilliant Minded Women Foundation Scholarship social media groups.
16. Membership in the Brilliant Minded Women Organization Network may be terminated at any time by Brilliant Minded Women Foundation, upon the occurrence of any behaviour on the part of the alumnus that Brilliant Minded Women Foundation, in its sole discretion, deems inappropriate.
